## July 2019

As we welcomed Summer here on the East coast, several areas in the West were getting snow! Some ski resorts reported up to 2 feet of snow (Steamboat got 20 inches) and others are still advertising skiing. Arapahoe Basin, Mammoth, Squaw, Snowbird, Timberline, and Whistler Blackcomb all will be open July 4<sup>th</sup>! So if you want to escape these high temperatures and humidity, you can take advantage of Spring skiing – with even more options available on the weekends. Meanwhile, our clubs are finding/planning fun summer things to do. Sandy McQuain is finalizing the Spring meeting minutes and we should get them to you by next week. During the Spring BOD meeting, ExComm was given approval to present an amended FY2020 proposed budget to the Fall BOD. Many hours and two (2) meetings (so far) have been spent working on the FY20 proposed budget. One big challenge is to have a balanced budget when Crescent has had less income and more expenses than in previous years. The majority of the decreased income is due to the changes with the Vendor Trade show at Spring Convention. Your ExComm is pleased with the progress we have made so far and we hope you will appreciate the extensive effort, time and ideas used in the development of this budget. The BOD will receive the proposed budget soon, but certainly 30 days prior to Fall Conference. Meanwhile, please be thinking of ways Crescent can increase our income as well as decrease spending.
